Our Engineered flooring line, the Significant Collection, is created using imported Polish FSC® Baltic Birch which is manufactured to meet or exceed the CARB Phase II Compliance standards.

Furthermore, Sheoga is one of only five manufacturers in the entire U.S. that has been certified to sell our products under the NWFA RPP (Responsible Procurement Program). This program is a joint initiative between leading environmental groups and industry manufacturers committed to producing and promoting wood floors from environmentally and socially responsible sources, improving forest sustainability for future generations. In addition, Sheoga has been certified by the Scientific Certification Systems (SCS) for Chain of Custody control and can sell our products under the FSC®-Mixed label.

All these steps showcase the level of commitment we feel to our world, community, employees, customers and distribution network. We take everyone's health and safety seriously and will continue to do so. Our future depends upon it.
