PART 1 - GENERAL

1.01 SUMMARY

A. Section Includes: Provides finished floor protection building paper

1.02 SUBMITTALS

- A. Product Data: Submit manufacturer's FORTIBOARD® literature for each type of membrane.
- B. Samples: Submit samples of each FORTIBOARD material.
- C. Quality Assurance/Control Submittals: Submit either test reports or manufacturer's certificates indicating materials comply with specified requirements available from Fortifiber upon request.

2.01 MANUFACTURER

- A. Fortifiber® Building Systems Group, 1-800-773-4777.
- B. Substitutions: Comply with provisions of Division 1.

2.02 MATERIALS

- A. Finished Floor Protection: Fortifiber® / Seekure® laminated glass fiber reinforced non-staining kraft building paper resistant to puncture, tears and abrasion.
 - 1. Tensile Strength: 54 lb f/in Machine Direction, 25 lb f/in Cross Machine Direction; ASTM D 828.
 - 2. Water Resistance: 5 hours minimum; ASTM D 779.
 - 3. Reference Standard: Federal Spec UU-B-790A, Type 1, Style 4

3.01 PREPARATION

A. Ensure, substrate is free of projections and irregularities which may be detrimental to proper installation of membrane.

3.02 INSTALLATION

- A. Apply FortiBoard either side up, logo up is preferred for inspection, laid smooth without folds of material.
 - 1 .Cut to fit area to be covered with utility knife.
 - 2. Place adjoining rolls next to each other.

3. Tape Seam: Butt adjoining FortiBoard roll and tape seam to hold adjoining rolls together with Permeable FortiBoard Tape (min. 6 perm with tape on board test by ASTM D770 FortiBoard Tape. Do not tape to finished surfaces.
